

## WEDDING STATIONERY TIMELINE

#### 12+ MONTHS BEFORE

Contact stationery designers for save the dates

(Feel free to contact them as soon as you have your date and location. For destination weddings, you may want to send save the dates a full year in advance.)

#### 6-9 MONTHS BEFORE

Send out save the dates

Contact stationery designers for invitations if you're looking for advanced printing techniques (letterpress, foil stamping, embossing, etc.)

#### 6 MONTHS BEFORE

Contact stationery designers for digitally-printed invitations

### 2-4 MONTHS BEFORE

Send out invitations

If you're sending out multiple waves of invitations or for a destination wedding, send out on the earlier side.

# 2 MONTHS BEFORE

Contact stationery designers for day of items (place cards, signage, menus, etc.)

### 1 MONTH BEFORE

Finalize day of items so they can print and ship before the wedding day.

It's better to order a few extras for people who you aren't sure will be there than to risk items not arriving on time at all!
